Vendor Information and Application Form

(Please note changes below)

This year:

- We accept three vendor categories. Priority will be given to:
 - Craft vendors** selling items that are handmade. This can include arts and crafts, jewelry, clothing, household items, fine art, dolls and stuffed animals that are made by the seller. We have space for up to **30** craft vendors.
 - Vendors of manufactured and mass-produced items and commercial services** will be limited to **10 spaces**.
 - Non-profit organizations and community groups** will be limited to **10 spaces**.

Political parties and political candidates or their representatives may not reserve a space

- Booth spaces are approximately 12' wide by 15' deep.
- One vehicle per booth space will be allowed. All others will need to park in the designated parking areas.
- **Upon check-in, one parking voucher will be given.** This is to go on the dashboard so that it is visible. Any vehicle parked in the vendor area without a parking voucher will be asked to move their vehicle. We only have limited space. This is for safety reasons for all persons.
- **Parking spaces in the designated parking areas CAN NOT be saved.**
- Vendors will be assigned spaces by Plainfield Friends. Indicate a preferred location on the map included with the application. We will try to place you there but cannot guarantee a specific spot.
- Vendors must supply their own tables and chairs. Electricity is available on part of the grounds. (minimum 100' extension cord recommended)
- We reserve the right to refuse any vendor whose product or presentation conflicts with our values and beliefs.
- No ready-to-eat food or beverages are to be sold on the grounds except by Plainfield Friends Meeting. This includes bake sale items. (Food designed to be prepared and consumed later, such as cookie mix or spice packets, may be sold)
- The festival will be held rain or shine. **No Refunds.**
- The cost of each booth space is **\$40.00** if registered by September 6, 2021.
- Registration after September 6, 2021 will be **\$50.00**.

Dear friends,

We are pleased to announce that we will begin accepting registrations for our annual Quaker Day Festival! The festival this year will be on **September 18, 2021**.

Food Trucks will be available on the grounds to purchase breakfast and lunch and treats!

The Chamber of Commerce is planning our annual **Quaker Day Parade!**

We are attaching a few documents:

- Registration for vendor space
- Covid-19 liability waiver (same as last year)
- A map of the grounds
- An information sheet with details about the festival

We have been in contact with the Hendricks County Health Department with regards to holding the festival this year.

We have decided the following for the Quaker Day Festival:

1. **We will begin with renting out 50 craft/vendor spaces on the property.** This is the same as last year. We are **hoping to expand the number of vendor spaces a little later this summer** – if the Covid-19 numbers remain low, we are expecting to be able to increase this.
2. **Initially, each vendor will be limited to renting 1 booth space.** Normally we allow up to two booth spaces. If we are able to expand the number of booth spaces if Covid-19 numbers remain low, then we will send out emails this summer to let you know. If so, you will have an opportunity to purchase another booth space – and we will make sure both spots are adjoining.
3. **Car Show – we are in the process of working on this.** We are really hoping to have one this year – we all missed it last year! We will send email updates about this.

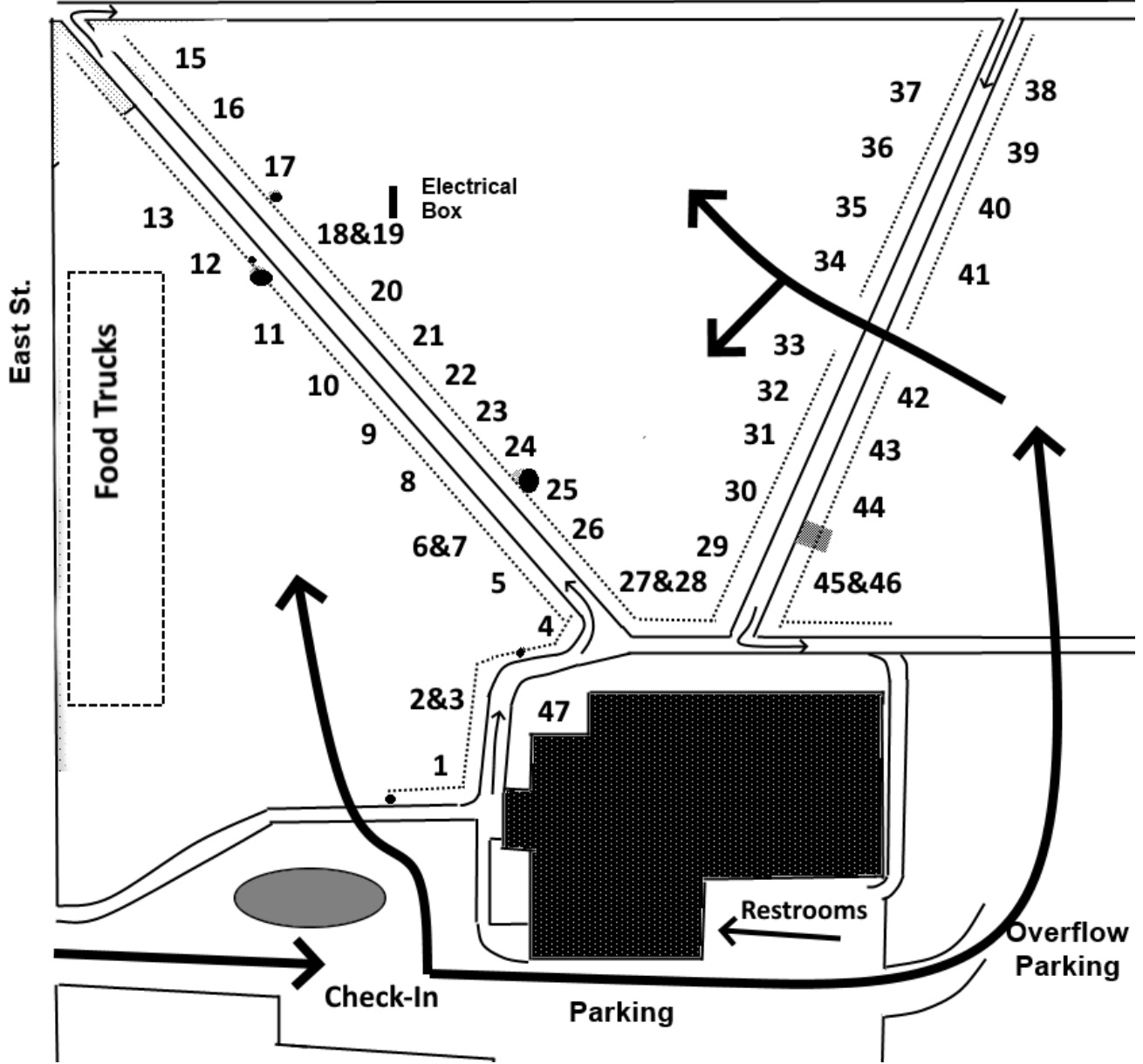
